## 1. THE UJA FEDERATION

### [The Morris M. Pulver Scholarship Fund Hushy Lipton Memorial Scholarship Fund](#)

#### **Eligibility:**

- Open to Canadian undergraduate, graduate, and post-graduate students who are residing in Canada.
- For students in need of financial aid.
- For students planning to study for a full academic year.
- Must have an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or its equivalent.
- For students who are eligible for full-time attendance at an associated recognized institutions of higher learning in Israel.

**Possible Award:** Needs based.

## 2. CANADIAN ZIONIST FEDERATION — DR. LEON ARYEH KRONITZ SCHOLARSHIP

#### **Eligibility:**

- Must be recent high school graduates, university students or graduate students pursuing teacher training or general studies in Israel.
- Open to Canadian citizens who demonstrate **financial need**.
- Must be accepted for at least one year at an accredited postsecondary program.

**Possible Award:** Varies.

**Application Process:** Three letters of recommendation required, one of which must be by a high school principal or university studies director.

## 3. SYNAGOGUE FUNDS

#### **Eligibility:**

- Many synagogues have funds for higher Jewish education offered to members of the congregation.

## 4. HEBREW UNIVERSITY OF JERUSALEM

\*\*\* The Doctoral Portion of this Scholarship continues to be suspended\*\*\*

### Lady Davis Fellowship Trust Fund

#### **Eligibility:**

- **Visiting Professorships** – you must be a full or an associate professor.
- **Post-doctoral researchers** – you must have received your Doctorate within the past four years.
- **Doctoral students** – you must be enrolled in a recognized doctoral program at a university outside Israel.

**Possible Award:** Varies.

**Application Process:** Lady Davis Fellowships are awarded after a rigorous academic review process. Candidates are ranked first at the Departmental level, and then at Faculty level. Prospective candidates must establish contact with the relevant Faculty or Department at the Hebrew University, and ensure that there is a Faculty member willing to sponsor the application. We will not be able to process an application without a sponsor.

**Requirements:** Visiting professors are typically expected to teach courses, participate in or lead seminars, engage in research with their hosts, or interact with other Faculty members. The precise mix of activities will be mutually decided upon by the Visitor and his/her academic sponsor.

### J. David Blazouske Memorial Doctoral Fellowship Fund

#### **Eligibility:**

- Available to qualified citizens of Canada, United Kingdom, or United States who are pursuing doctoral studies in business, economics or a related field at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. This endowment fund is designed to attract doctoral students of outstanding academic achievement from the above countries to the Hebrew University to pursue doctoral studies in the above fields.

**Possible Award:** \$10,000 CAD.

### Rothberg International School Graduate Merit Scholarship

#### **Eligibility:**

- To be considered, candidates must have completed their undergraduate degree and have a minimum GPA of 3.8 or equivalent. Any candidate for an M.A. program may apply and those selected will be eligible for a two-year fellowship, conditional on maintenance of academic performance. Candidates for any other graduate program are not eligible to apply for the Graduate Merit Fellowship.

**Award:** The cost of full tuition for an academic year. Needs based awards available.

## 5. THE DENNIS WALDMAN FOUNDATION FOR JEWISH EDUCATION

### Eligibility:

- Open to students in their final year of high school who intend to pursue university-level study.

### Requirements:

Academic achievement, teacher references, extra-curricular activities, service to the community, and an essay.

**Possible Award:** Varies.

**Application Process:** Applications are available beginning in January. Applicant must submit an application by mail or in person.

## 6. MEMORIAL FOUNDATION FOR JEWISH CULTURE

### [International Doctoral Scholarship for Studies Specializing in Jewish Fields](#)

### Eligibility:

- Any graduate student specializing in a Jewish field that is officially enrolled or registered in a doctoral program at a recognized university.
- Open to applicants who have had their dissertation approved.

**Possible Award:** The amount of the scholarship varies in accordance with the cost of living in the country where the student is studying. Grants range up to \$10,000 USD a year. Grants are given for one academic year. They can be renewed, upon submission of a new application and supporting documents, up to a maximum of four years.

**Application Process:** Applications can be obtained on individual written request from the Memorial Foundation for Jewish Culture, 50 Broadway, 34th Floor, New York, NY 10004, U.S.A.

## International Fellowship in Jewish Studies and Jewish Culture

### **Eligibility:**

- Any qualified scholar, researcher or artist who possesses the knowledge and experience to formulate and implement a project in a field of Jewish specialization.

**Possible Award:** The amount of the grant varies in accordance with the cost of living in the country in which the fellowship recipient resides. Grants range up to \$10,000 USD per year. Grants are for one academic year. Ordinarily, no more than two grants will be made to an individual.

**Application Process:** Applications can be obtained on individual written request from the Memorial Foundation for Jewish Culture, 50 Broadway, 34th Floor, New York, NY 10004, U.S.A.

## **7. CANADIAN GOVERNMENT STUDENT LOANS**

### **Eligibility:**

- Open to those planning to attend a post-secondary institution. Must be able to demonstrate financial need.

*NOTE: It is very important to apply for student loans as your eligibility for these loans may make you eligible for many other awards.*

**Possible Award:** Varies.

*REMINDER: These are loans that must be repaid.*

**Application Process:** Dependent on each province.

## **8. MASA SCHOLARSHIPS**

### **Eligibility:**

- Applicants must be Jewish.
- Applicants cannot be a new immigrant or citizen of Israel.
- Applicants must never have participated in a long-term program in Israel that began after 1<sup>st</sup> September 2004.
- Applicants must have graduated high school and be under the age of 31 at the start of the program.

**Possible Award:** Dependent on program and duration.

## 9. BETH TZEDEC MEN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP FUND — NATIONAL

### Eligibility:

- Open to all Canadians.
- Not restricted to Beth Tzedec congregants.
- Preference will be given to students who study Jewish topics. Various scholarship funds available.

**Possible Award:** Varies per year, up to \$1,000 CAD.

### Application Process:

- Fill out the application form. Include your most recent transcript.
- Should be submitted to the contact address.
