

Award: Up to \$3,500 CAD Annually

The Rabbi Erwin Schild Student Scholarship Fund was generously established at the Hebrew University in 2023 by **Julie Di Lorenzo** as a tribute to Rabbi Schild. The Rabbi is a highly respected member of the Clergy, an accomplished author, a stalwart community leader, and a dear personal friend of Ms. Di Lorenzo.

Rabbi Schild was born in 1920 in Cologne, Germany. He likes to refer to his early biography as **"a Canadian Footnote to the Holocaust "**. After his ordination as Rabbi in 1947 he served as the Rabbi of **Adath Israel Congregation** for 42 years and is now in retirement as Rabbi Emeritus. He is renowned for his efforts to promote interfaith harmony and improve Christian-Jewish relations both locally and globally, and is admired for his charitable nature, dedication to multiculturalism, and positive interfaith relations.

As Rabbi Schild is passionate about Israel and Jewish Studies, this meaningful scholarship will annually award up to **CDN \$3,500** to a deserving Canadian student, with a preference for those studying **Judaic Studies** at **The Hebrew University in Jerusalem**, though other fields of study will also be considered. Applicants from any degree level may apply for the 2024-2025 school year.

Eligibility:

- Must be a Canadian citizen residing in Canada
- Scholarship will be awarded to students preferably, but not limited to studying Judaic Studies at the Hebrew University
- Applicants must have a GPA of 3.5 or above

Requirements: Resume • Official Transcript • Two Academic References
